Contact Tracing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ QR Codes available for scanning.</li> <li>✓ Attendance Record to be signed.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Attendees MUST scan QR Code upon entering the venue AND the PRS QR Code at sign in.</li> <li>• Attendees are encouraged to bring their own pen.</li> </ul>
Physical Distancing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Seating to be placed 1m apart.</li> <li>✓ Manikins to be placed approx 2m apart allowing 1m distance between participants.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Reduced class sizes may be required to allow space for physical distancing.</li> <li>• Participants are encouraged to be mindful of physical distancing practices during the session to keep themselves and others safe.</li> </ul>
Face Coverings	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Face coverings are to be worn during all training sessions.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• It is the responsibility of the individual to provide their own face covering to wear for the duration of the training session.</li> </ul>
Hand Hygiene	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Hand sanitiser will be available for use at entry and exit of the venue.</li> <li>✓ Gloves are to be worn by participants when demonstrating all practical aspects of the training session</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Participants are encouraged to wash their hands or use sanitiser frequently through the training session.</li> <li>• PRS will provide a gel based sanitiser for use during training sessions.</li> <li>• Gloves are to be provided by the individual for use use in practical aspects of the training session.</li> </ul>
Equipment	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Chairs and tables at venues to be cleaned before and after training session.</li> <li>✓ Manikins, AED, Bag masks, &amp; Airway equipment will be cleaned before and after participant contact.</li> <li>✓ Attempted ventilations will NOT be performed on manikins.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• All seating and tables will be disinfected by PRS staff before and after each training session.</li> <li>• All clothing will be removed from the Adult and Child manikins, However, Infant manikins cannot be undressed. Gloves are to be worn when performing all practical aspects in the training session.</li> </ul>

PRS will communicate with key contacts of venues to ensure health and safety measures are in place, practical to the environment and in keeping with any venue protocols. PRS will ensure these measures are adhered to for the safety of the key contacts, participants and PRS faculty.

Information on COVID control measures has been communicated to all staff and contractors of PRS and are regularly reminded of the measures in place.
